## Healthcare Professionals Study Days

Our Study Day programme is aimed at Healthcare Professionals who work or have an interest in the field of spinal cord injury. Along with our SCI Nurse Specialists, we have speakers from Spinal Cord Injury Centres or other clinical settings who are experts in their field.

## Good Clinical Practice in Spinal Cord Injury

Delivered in-house, this Study Day gives an overview of the key issues affecting spinal cord injured people, such as autonomic dysreflexia, bladder and bowel management and care of the skin.

## Managing The Neurogenic Bowel Following Spinal Cord Injury

Tailored for groups of up to six, participants will examine the theory and practise that underpins effective management of the neurogenic bowel. Learning will be evaluated via a written exam and case study work. Delegates will have the opportunity to demonstrate the skills and knowledge to safely undertake Digital Rectal Examination, Digital Rectal Stimulation and Digital Removal of Faeces during a practical session on an anatomical training model.

## Virtual education

We can offer virtual education sessions on key topics associated with spinal cord injury such as Autonomic Dysreflexia, bladder and bowel management under our Managing Spinal Cord Injury module, as well as a theory only version of our Managing the Neurogenic Bowel Following Spinal Cord Injury training day.
