

VIRTUAL EDUCATION SESSIONS IN SPINAL CORD INJURY

Spinal Injuries Association (SIA) is delighted to be able to offer Trusts and healthcare organisations the opportunity to increase their staff's knowledge of spinal cord injury (SCI) by offering live virtual education sessions via Zoom, facilitated by members of our team of SCI Nurse Specialists and arranged for a date and time convenient to you.

There are two options available:

Managing Spinal Cord Injury: Tailored to the needs of the requestor, you select the topics most relevant to you and your patients. This is a topic-based education session based on the subjects covered in our popular Good Clinical Practice in SCI inhouse Study Day. A basic session includes the Introduction to Spinal Cord Injury presentation, plus one other topic of your choice. More topics can be added for an additional charge, and where possible we will also include a session by one of our Support Network Officers.

Managing the Neurogenic Bowel Following SCI (theory only): This module will provide delegates with the knowledge required to underpin their practice within the areas of Digital Rectal Examination (DRE), Digital Rectal Stimulation (DRS) and Digital Removal of Faeces (DRF) for spinal cord injured people. This module does not include skills training or practical assessment. Prior to attending, delegates will be asked to provide the contact information of a Registered Nurse who has agreed to be responsible for the assessment and supervision of DRE, DRS and/or DRF.

SESSION CONTENT & COSTINGS

Managing Spinal Cord Injury

Basic session (approx 2 hours): **Cost: £160 +vat**

Introduction to Spinal Cord Injury presentation, plus one topic from the list below.

Additional topics: Cost: £45 +vat each

- Autonomic Dysreflexia
- Neurogenic Bowel Management
- Neurogenic Bladder Management
- Care of the Skin
- Respiratory Function Following SCI
- Psychological and Emotional Support

These costs are the minimum charge, and include up to 3 delegates. Up to 7 further delegates can be added for £50 +vat each per basic session and £15 +vat each per additional topic.

Managing the Neurogenic Bowel Following SCI (approx 4 hours)

Provides delegates with the education required to underpin their practice within the areas of DRE, DRS and DRF for spinal cord injured people. Prior to attending, delegates will be asked to provide the contact information of a Registered Nurse who has agreed to be responsible for the assessment and supervision of these practices. After the session, delegates will complete an online evaluation of learning exercise, which will be marked by the SCI Nurse Specialists. Those who achieve the required pass mark will be awarded a certificate confirming this that they can then present to the supervising RN.

Cost: £300 +vat. This cost is the minimum charge, and includes up to 3 delegates. Up to 3 further delegates can be added for £100 +vat each.

Where possible we will also include a session by one of our Support Network Officers in both of the options above. All education is CPD accredited, and delegates will also be sent a pack of electronic materials to support the sessions.
